EFAS Offers TWO Travelling Fellowships in Europe

The European Foot and Ankle Society is inviting applications for the 2012 Travelling Fellowship. The Fellowship is available to two trainee orthopaedic surgeons* interested in foot and ankle surgery.

The Fellows will travel to 3 European centres proposed by the Council of EFAS, visiting, observing and assisting some of the top foot and ankle surgeons in Europe. The Fellowship will commence in September 2012 for approximately 2 weeks. The proposed centres will be confirmed in due course and the Fellowship will commence with fellows participating and received free registration and accommodation to attend the 9th EFAS Congress in The Netherlands. **Applicants must confirm availability to travel between 5th -22nd September 2012 in order to be eligible.** The selected fellows will be requested to present a brief report on the experience at a future EFAS course/congress.

*Eligibility: Medically qualified trainee orthopaedic surgeons (not yet certified), of European Nationality and working within Europe, with specific interest and experience in the field of foot and ankle. Applicants must be aged 38 years or less on 1st January 2012.

*Centres: The proposed centres may change due to circumstances beyond the control of EFAS in which case alternative centres will be used.

*Expenses: Basic travel expenses for economy travel, economy bed and breakfast accommodation each centre will be provided with extras to be covered by the fellows. Successful applicants will be required to make travel and accommodation arrangements themselves with costs pre-approved by EFAS and submit an invoice for travel and accommodation following the fellowship programme.
